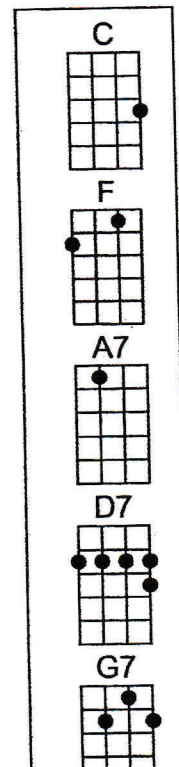
Instrumental first verse
