

QUICK LESSON 3 17th JULY 2020

In lesson 1 we learned the d dud d strum using the chords to the song "Let It Be"

In lesson 2 we learned the 2 Riffs that are used at the end of each verse and chorus. The first Riff is an easier option and is the first one to learn.

The second Riff is a bit more challenging using your little finger with a stretch from 3rd fret to 7th fret. When the song is played either option is fine and when some play the first Riff and others play the more challenging Riff the combined effect can be very effective. (See also note at bottom of page)

Lesson 3

In this lesson we are simply going to learn the Chords for Chorus 1 (there are actually 3 variations of the chorus 1 in the actual song. For our purposes once we have learned chorus 1 we would play it for 2 and 3 but the words will alter.

Chorus 1 (4 BEATS PER BOX)

G	D	C	G
G	D	C	G

NOTE: PLAY ONE OF THE RIFFS OVER THESE CHORDS

Resist the temptation to simply learn the song at this stage once we have completed lesson 3 we have the structure of the song and so will go on to actually learn it.

My aim is for us to learn in a consistent manner and to take all levels of experience along so everyone can participate.

Note:

For novice players it is possible to join in without playing either of the Riffs, you would simply strum the C and G chords once and count as follows C234 G234
