

Over the past weeks we have been learning the structure of the song Let it Be. We have used this song to learn new skills and techniques. These are techniques that really bring a song to life. As always every level from relative beginner to more experienced can take something from the Lessons and make a valuable contribution to the overall sound. We have worked on strumming and the riff options within the song. These riff options are included with the song sheet for you to download if you haven't already. You will find the song sheet by pressing the Button marked Let It Be, its in the Quick Lessons drop down menu.

Our final riff can be a challenge but taken slowly and building up speed I am confident you can learn the one that is appropriate for you.

Interlude/Ending

The first is best if you are fairly new to playing and will work well as others play the more challenging ones.

Easy option 1: I have demonstrated this in a short video on our website in the Quick lessons Menu.

This is the one most people who are experienced or are up for a challenge will play.

Use the video to help you firstly understand how it sounds and then secondly to go through it slowly until you can play it at the correct tempo for the song. Identify on the song sheet where it fits in.

There are other options of the Interlude riff for you to try out also.

Just a word about playing in the context of the song. As with any riffs it is one thing to learn them in isolation it is another thing entirely to play them within a song! So be patient with yourself and practice, practice, practice playing the song through with the riffs.
