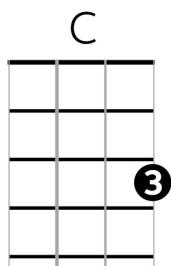
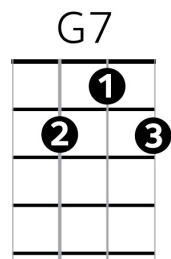


Sloop John B

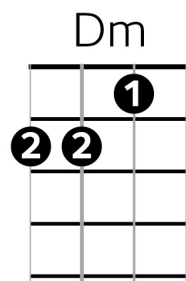
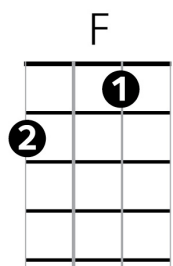
