






2. Chorus


This riff appears in each of the three **Choruses**. It can be plucked while other players strum the chords. 4 beats per measure.





3. Bridge


This riff appears in the **Bridge**. It can be plucked while other players strum the chords. 4 beats per measure.



4. Chorus vocals
